Network Objectives



- 1) Facilitate research on how <u>social and geographic exposures</u> across <u>micro to macro contexts</u> <u>separately and collectively</u> shape trends and disparities overall and by <u>gender</u>, <u>race/ethnicity</u>, and <u>SES</u> across the life course
- 2) Forge collaborations between scientists with expertise in:
- (1) <u>life course influences</u> on health and longevity and (2) <u>geographic variation</u> in health and longevity
 - → specific layers of geography (e.g., neighborhoods, rural areas, states)
- 3) Provide <u>development and training opportunities</u> to research across career stages




