

**Jack Lahey, MSW**

Jack is the Director of Resident Programs at Skid Row Housing Trust (the Trust), a leading non-profit in developing affordable, permanent supportive housing and providing on-site resident services to break the cycle of homelessness. He oversees all programming for residents and is involved with leading the Trust to increase its services to better address and support a fragile aging population. Before that he served as a Research Coordinator on two projects: the National Institute on Aging (NIA) grant exploring early onset of geriatric conditions in Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH), and the LA County Homeless Count Demographic Survey. He also assisted on the National Institute of Drug Abuse (NIDA) Transition to Housing on the delivery and analysis of the project. He has worked in homeless services as a Program Manager and Case Manager at various agencies throughout Los Angeles County. Jack obtained his MSW from the USC School of Social Work and a BA in History from Fordham University.
